

NOTE ON PLACE NAMES AND TERMS USED IN THE TEXT



Except for place names for which there are commonly accepted English terms, such as Prague or Vienna, when a place name first appears, we list the relevant language variants of the name (most often Czech and German) according to the appropriate context. On subsequent occasions, we use only the name currently common in the local language.

Note also that we distinguish between the use of the term ‘veterans’ as an adjectival noun and the use of the genitive plural referring to actions or attitudes of veterans. Hence, we refer to veterans associations, veterans groups, veterans internationalism, etc. using the adjectival form, but to veterans’ attitudes, veterans’ activities, etc. using the possessive form.
